

KANIDOLOKEE (a karaoke singing competition)

Rules and Regulations Documentation

Please note that by registering for the competition, all contestants agree to all terms and conditions as listed here (including regular updates, as posted). Contestants **MUST BE** over the age of nineteen (19) to qualify for the Toronto Grand Finale in June. By submitting your candidacy to the KANIDOLOKEE competition, you acknowledge the fact that you have read all information posted online regarding the KANIDOLOKEE competition and understood all of its content.

1 GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

NOTE: Awake Entertainment Alliance is hereinafter referred to as "*The producer*". All correspondence and mail-outs, including registration payments are to be directed to Awake Entertainment Alliance,; 2107 Danforth Ave.; Suite 180.; Toronto, Ontario, M4C 1K1. - Competition is open to men and women of 19 years of age and up. Should a candidate under the age of nineteen (19) perform and win at the local level, The Producer reserves the right to accept or refuse access to the Toronto Grand Finale on June 9th 2006 based on liquor laws in place at the time. Every competitor hereby assigns irrevocably to The Producer the entire copyrights and all other rights of whatsoever nature, including without limitation, my performance, any comments ascribed to me and any incidental inclusion of my name and/or likeness howsoever caused, such that The Producers shall be entitled to use and exploit and license others to use an exploit such contribution, in whole or in part, by all means and in all media and formats whether now known or hereinafter invented throughout the universe for the full term of copyright and thereafter insofar as it is possible in perpetuity.
- No weapons or nonprescription controlled substances will be permitted to be brought into the Toronto Grand Finale session. At the local level, competitors may perform wearing clothing of their choice (without restrictions). Restrictions related to clothing may apply during the Grand Finale in Toronto. Contestants will be advised of such restrictions upon being selected.
- The producer reserves the right to limit the number of entries at his or her discretion, add competition nights and reschedule and/or relocate either the local or Grand Finale event location giving 14 days notice by e-mail to all registered applicants.
- Each week, our computer will tabulate the scores obtained from all online fan submitted scores and FINALISTS will be announced during the last week of the competition through the MUSICWAKE.COM website.
- The producer reserves the right to change the structure of the competition as it sees fit including, without limitation, adding or deleting auditions/heat's/competitors to the competition and/or requesting additional performances from the competitors and/or changing the anticipated auditioning for recording schedule.
- Any contestant who makes it to the Finals and is not able to physically attend, automatically forfeits any claims to prizes and other considerations which they may be otherwise entitled to.

2 THE ONLINE REGISTRATION PROCESS

- Contestants interested in competing **MUST BE REGISTERED ONLINE**, through this site (www.musicwake.com), to qualify for doors prizes, grand prizes and to have their name entered into the NATIONAL ONLINE RATING SYSTEM. No contestant will be allowed into the Grand Finale without having a valid registration from this site.
- After registering online, contestant will receive the welcome kit, by mail and within 10 days of registering. Contestant may begin performing while waiting for the kit to arrive. The Contestant should choose one preferred location from the online list and may perform as often as desired.

NOTE: Contestants are advised that the system recognizes only ONE REGISTRATION PER LOCATION. Should contestant wish to perform and be rated at more than one location, they will be required to register for that location as well. Keep in mind that performing more than once may lower your average score (for example, if contestant's score on 2nd performance is less than what was scored on its 1st performance, the contestant's average will drop). Finalists are determined by tabulation of total online votes by attending audience members.

REGISTRATION FEE – Each contestant is required to pay an entry fee of \$34.50 (includes all taxes) which will include their posting on the website, their official neck pass and complimentary t-shirt and gift as part of the welcome kit. This fee is NON REFUNDABLE and NON TRANSFERABLE.

3 THE GRAND FINALE AND CROWNING NIGHT

- The top performer from every participating bar (as determined by the online rating system) will be invited to attend the Grand Finale to take place in Toronto this June 9th. Transportation to the Grand Finale may be provided to the contestant.
- Prize list and other sponsored considerations may vary and are subject to adjustments until the day of the Grand Finale. The producer reserves the right to substitute prize allocation, at its discretion, for as long as such changes are in line with the overall valuation of the offered prizes (i.e. similar adequate replacements).
- Should any contestant make it to the Grand Finale, it is a condition of participation that the candidate may be required to enter into the following agreements with *The Producer*: a merchandising and sponsorship agreement, a management agreement and/or any sort of professional representation before their appearance in the Grand Finale. Should the candidate already be in a professional representation agreement, the negotiating of a co- management/representation agreement may be acceptable to *The Producer*.
- The Producer shall not be liable to me or my legal representative for any loss or damage or injury to me or my property caused by or suffered during or in connection with my taking part in the program, including without limitation, as a result of personal injury, invasion of privacy, libel, defamation or infringement of copyright, unless caused by the negligence of the producer and recoverable on that ground following judgment of a competent court of final judgment.
- All competitors agree not to disclose to any third party any information relating to the program or the affairs of the producer that may come to my knowledge during or in connection with my participation in the program.
- I acknowledge, as a candidate, that no fees, royalties, residuals or other consideration will be payable to me in respect of any broadcast, subsequent rebroadcast or retransmission or any other use by the producer of the program or any part thereof in any manner or media now known or hereinafter invented.
